- **acanthus m.** *bear's breeches*, large exotic perennial, lobed dark green leaves, tall spikes of white flowers with purple stripes
- **aconitum** "Bicolor" *monkshood*, dark green glossy foliage with tall spikes of blue & white hooded flowers
- **aconitum** "Blue Lagoon" *monkshood*, a shorter selection with bright blue flowers that start lower on the stem than typical aconitums
- **agapanthus** "Hardy Blue" *African lily* produces full clumps of thick grasslike foliage 12" high, mid-summer, 30" stems hold heads of deep blue flowers
- **agastache** "Golden Jubilee", *anise hyssop*, fragrant golden foliage and tall spikes of lavender-purple flowers
- **agastache** "Raspberry Summer" large dark raspberry-pink blooms adorn plant all summer, easy to grow in good drainage
- **ajuga** "Black Scallop" small scale ground cover with glossy black scalloped leaves, deep blue flowers in spring
- **allium** "Globemaster" early spring, sends up shiny green strap-like foliage followed by stout upright stems topped with shiny globe of flower buds that open to a 10" diameter mass of lilac-pink flowers
- **alstromeria** "Mauve Majesty" mauve-pink flowers with dark spots atop neat upright plant
- **anchusa** "Azura" clusters of brilliant blue flowers in late spring
- **anemone** "Pamina" *windflower*, large purple-pink double flowers
- **anemone** "September Charm" large, single, pink blooms on graceful stems late summer
- **anemone leveillei** large white cupped flowers with purple-blue stamens, low and shrubby in appearance, blooms mid spring
- **antirrhinum h.** "Roseum" *perennial snapdragon* rose-pink flowers over silvery-blue foliage, begins blooming in June, and continues all summer
- **aquilegia** "Spitfire" *columbine* petite hybrid with red-orange flowers
- **arabis** "Little Treasure" spreading groundcover with vibrant rose-pink blossoms, excellent performer
- **arisaema f.** "Hugo"
- **arisaema t.** "Silver Heron" beautiful foliage plant with pewter patterns on leaves, for the woodland garden
- **arisaema urashima** interesting purple and white striped spathe
- **arisarum proboscideum** unique spring plant that appears with purple and white flowers and a 6" stem that resembles a mouse's tail, summer dormant
- **artemesia** "Silver Mound" soft feathery leaves form compact cushion-like mound
- **aruncus** "Misty Lace" nice medium size plant for smaller gardens, large creamy white plumes on dark red stems
- **asclepias tuberosa**, *butterfly milkweed* longlasting tangerine orange flowers
- **astilbe** "Vision in Pink" pale pink plumes with dense upright form, robust clump
- **astilbe** "Visions in Red" deep red buds open to dense fuzzy plumes of pinkish-red, red stems and bronze foliage enhance its beauty
- **baptisia sphaerocarpa yellow wild indigo** striking yellow pea-like flowers early summer, followed by attractive seed heads, nice upright blue-green foliage
- **begonia** "Wildwood Premier" olive-gold leaves with red stems and veins, typical begonia pink flowers in late summer, **yes, its hardy!**
- **belamcanda** "Hello Yellow" *blackberry lily*, iris-like foliage, bright yellow star shaped flowers

- **brunnera** "Emerald Mist" light silver overlay on bright green leaves, baby-blue, forget-me-not flowers
- **brunnera** "Jack Frost" silver overlay and green veining on large heart shaped leaves, sprays of tiny sky-blue forget-me-not flowers
- **brunnera m.** "Spring Yellow" unusual gold foliage misted with green, light blue flowers in spring
- **campanula** "Blue-Eyed Blond" brilliant yellow foliage gives rise to large bells of deep blue, refined and well mannered
- **campanula** "Pearl Deep Blue" *bellflower*, cup shaped upward-facing deep violet blue flowers
- **campanula** "Pink Octopus" Japanese-lantern buds open to striking pink octopus-like flowers fluttering from strong upright plant
- **centaurea** "Amethyst in Snow", clump forming, sturdy mass of grey-green leaves with a silver cast, flowers are silky, pure white petals that radiate in a starburst from deep royal purple center
- **centaurea** "Gold Bullion" *bachelor's button*, deep blue flowers late spring over bright gold foliage all summer
- **centranthus r.** "Coccineus" versatile plant, showy rose-red flowers are continuous from late spring thru late summer
- **ceratostigma** *dwarf plumbago*, groundcover with clusters of peacock blue flowers summer to fall, foliage turns stunning red in autumn, sun or shade
- **chelone** "Hot Lips" *turtlehead* long blooming spikes of rosy pink flowers
- **chelone g.** "Black Ace" spring foliage emerges with black cast turning dark green, produces spikes holding milky, white turtlehead flowers
- **chelone o.** "Rosea" a light pink selection of *turtlehead*
- **cimicifuga** "Hillside Black Beauty" *black snakeroot*, dark purple-black foliage on tall plant with long bottlebrush fragrant flowers in late summer
- **cimicifuga** "Brunette" *bugbane*, dark purple-black foliage topped by white bottlebrush flowers late summer into fall, amazing fragrance, tolerates shade
- **clematis h.** "China Purple" *bush clematis*, stunning dark purple flowers top upright plant, 30" tall
- **coreopsis** "Crème Brulee" similar to "Moonbeam" but larger flowers and improved mildew resistance
- **coreopsis** "Elphin Gold" very compact form with numerous orange-yellow daisy-like flowers from May thru Sept.
- **coreopsis** "Full Moon" bright canary-yellow flowers up to 3" across, well branched plant
- **coreopsis** "Heavens Gate" two toned flowers of pink and rosy-crimson about 1" wide, shear back late spring for fuller plant with more buds, blooms all summer
- **coreopsis** "Jethro Tull" *tickseed* golden flowers with fluted petals atop compact mound of foliage, very floriferous
- **coreopsis** "Lightening Flash" new bold cultivar with striking gold foliage and bright yellow flowers mid-summer
- **coreopsis** "Little Sundial" compact upright plant that produces masses of single golden flowers with a maroon eye over a long period in summer
- **coreopsis** "Moonbeam" lemon yellow flowers over threadleaf foliage, all summer bloom
- **coreopsis** "Presto" dwarf habit, 2" golden-yellow flowers, naturally compact
- **corydalis** "Berry Exciting" brilliant golden foliage, streaked with green, erupts with fragrant purple flowers, does not go summer dormant
- **crocosmia** "George Davidson" long-lasting soft-orange flowers rise above sword-like foliage
- **crocosmia** "Lucifer" Brilliant flame red flowers above broad swordlike foliage
- **crocosmia** "Walberton Yellow" large golden-yellow blossoms on upright stems, sword-like foliage
- **delosperma** "Table Mountain" *iceplant*, fuschia colored flowers, like little stars, bloom all summer
- **delosperma c.** "Gold Nugget" super hardy ice plant, so prolific, the lemon-yellow flowers hide its succulent foliage
- **delphinium** "Blue Butterfly" dwarf form well branched, spectacular show of deep blue flowers
- **delphinium** "Blue Lace" sky-blue flowers on tall strong stems
- **delphinium** "Double Innocence"

➤ **delphinium** "Summer Blues" sky blue flowers on compact, well branched plant

➤ **delphinium** "Summer Morning" dwarf form, lacy mounds of foliage with a multitude of light pink flowers, early bloomer

➤ **delphinium** "Summer Nights" midnight blue flowers on compact well branched plant

➤ **dianthus** "HeartAttack" *perennial sweet William*, deep crimson red flowers over glossy lance-like foliage, new leaves emerge red

➤ **dianthus** "Neon Star" fluorescent pink flowers, spicy clove scent, evergreen blue-grey foliage

➤ **dianthus** "Tiny Rubies" *cheddar pinks*, double, rose-pink, clove scented flowers over grassy evergreen foliage,

➤ **dicentra** "Gold Heart" *old fashioned bleeding heart*, heart shaped pink flowers dangling below bright gold foliage

➤ **dicentra** "King of Hearts" *fernleaf bleeding heart*, vigorous sun and heat tolerant cultivar with unstoppable blooms of rose-pink and soft lacy foliage

➤ **dicentra** "Snowdrift" pure white heart shaped flowers above mounds of grey-green ferny foliage, late spring til fall

➤ **dicentra** "Spectabilis" *old fashioned bleeding heart*, bushy clumps of green leaves on fleshy stems, strings of pink heart shaped flowers dangle below

➤ **dicentra** "Zestful" everblooming fern leaf bleeding heart, does not go summer dormant

➤ **digitalis** "Spice Island" *foxglove* peachy yellow flowers dusted with nutmeg top evergreen foliage

➤ **digitalis grandiflora** *yellow foxglove*, from large rosettes of foliage, emerge

butter-yellow flowers on strong stout spikes

➤ **doronicum** "Leonardo" early blooming *leopard bane*, compact plant, yellow daisy-like flowers

➤ **dracunculus vulgaris** "Dragon Lily", Z5 hardy with a little protection, this exotic looking 12" flower **STINKS TO HIGH HEAVEN** for about a day, the huge purple flower lasts for about a week, the ensuing foliage is very attractive, goes summer dormant



➤ **echinacea** "After Midnight" distinctive dwarf selection, fragrant, dark magenta-purple flowers with wide overlapping petals and a black-red cone on black stems, well branched compact plant

➤ **echinacea** "All that Jazz" unique new hybrid with completely quilled ray petals, fragrant lavender-pink flowers atop strong, tall stems

➤ **echinacea** "Fatal Attraction" vivid purple-pink flowers with 2 rows of perky petals sit on dark red-nearly-black stems

➤ **echinacea** "Harvest Moon" earthy gold fragrant flowers on sturdy well branched plant

➤ **echinacea** "Merlot" huge 5" wide rose-pink flowers top stunning burgundy black stems, great fragrance!!

➤ **echinacea** "Pink Double Delight", 20-24" plant is well branched and floriferous, double-pink blooms begin in July and continue for 6-8 weeks

➤ **echinacea** "Prairie Splendor" 4-6" rosy pink flowers, blooms from early summer til fall, compact plants

➤ **echinacea** "Summer Sky" the first bi-colored coneflower, tall stems support 5" flowers of light orange with a rose halo and orange cone

➤ **echinacea** "Sundown" vibrant orange blossoms, rose scented, tall sturdy plant

➤ **echinacea** "Sunrise" *coneflower* citron-yellow, daisy-like flowers, rose scented,

➤ **echinacea** "Tiki Torch" the darkest orange coneflower to date, 4½" flowers with wide petals, "Tiki Torch" retains its intense color for weeks, spicy scented flowers sit atop strong upright stems

➤ **echinacea** "Virgin" selected for superior flowering performance, large fragrant pure white flowers with a green cone, double row of petals, upright habit

➤ **eremurus** i. "Shelford Hybrids" mixed colors of *foxtail lily*

➤ **eryngium** "Jade Frost" *sea holly* leathery blue-green leaves with prominent white margins that are pink in cooler weather, candelabra-ish branches hold violet-blue flowers

➤ **eupatorium** d. "Little Joe" compact *Joe Pye weed*

➤ **fallopia** j., "Variegata" *Japanese fleece flower*, huge upright clump of unusual heart shaped creamy leaves splashed with dark green, new growth is

- **filipendula rubra**, "Venusta", *queen of the meadow*, tall perennial with divided palmate leaves topped with full sprays of tiny pink flowers
- **gaillardia** "Arizona Sun" *blanket flower*, petite form with impressive flower power, blooms all summer
- **gaillardia** "Amber Wheels" *blanket flower*, large golden flowers with fringed petals and prominent amber-red centers, blooms all summer



- **gaillardia** "Burgandy" *blanket flower*, large wine red flowers all season
- **gaillardia** "The Sun", *blanket flower*, golden yellow daisy flowers, blooms all summer
- **gaultheria wintergreen**, outstanding groundcover in woodland garden, shiny dark green leaves and red edible berries

- **gaura** l. "Crimson Butterfly" compact plant with crimson foliage and soft pink butterfly flowers, blooms spring til frost
- **gaura** l. "Snow Fountain" abundant blush to white buds and blooms from late spring to fall on strong stems
- **gentiana** "Lagodechiana", *gentian*, easy to grow in part shade, 8-12', bright blue upturned flowers
- **geranium** "Midnight Reiter", **spectacular** deep purple foliage and dark lilac flowers
- **geranium** "Orkney Cherry" bronze foliage, bright pink flowers June to Sept on compact plant
- **geranium** "Perfect Storm" a storm of small magenta-pink flowers on low mounds of foliage
- **geranium** "Rozanne" [2008 perennial of the year], fast growing, long blooming make this a winner in the garden, violet-blue flowers all summer
- **geranium** "Sandrine" large 2" magenta-purple flowers are produced over a long period
- **geranium** "Starman" unique color patterns, purplish pink flowers with fuschia veining in the center, blooms all summer
- **gunnera manicata** plant of enormous proportions, up to 8' high with 4-5' leaves
- **heliopsis** "Lorraine Sunshine" *false sunflower*, variegated white leaves with green veining, golden yellow daisy-like flowers
- **heliopsis** "Prairie Sunset", *false sunflower*, purple veined leaves on dark purple stems set off golden flowers with wine eyes
- **heliopsis** "Summer Nights" *false sunflower*, golden yellow flowers with mahogany centers top dark red stems and red tinged foliage **stunning!**
- **heliopsis** h. "Tuscan Sun" *false sunflower* nice compact native

heliopsis, tons of golden-yellow daisies mid-summer, long blooming

- **helleborus** "Blue Lady", 12-18" plants produce bushy clumps of leathery evergreen leaves, flowers of deep plum-purple appear early spring
- **helleborus** "Royal Heritage Mix" *Lenten rose*, a mix of colors ranging from purple, near-black to white, green, pink or red
- **helleborus** "Wester Flisk" *bearsfoot hellebore*, bronze tinted foliage
- **helleborus** o. "Swirlin' Skirts" double white selection with a full robust habit, deep green glossy foliage
- **hemerocallis** "Apricot Sparkles" *daylily*, everblooming dwarf selection with deep apricot ruffled blooms, starts early and reblooms til frost
- **hemerocallis** "Razzamatazz" *miniature daylily*, compact plant with bright purple flowers, blooms nearly all summer
- **hemerocallis** "Ruby Stella", 12-22" plant, vibrant wine-red flowers all summer
- **herniaria glabra** *green carpet* bright green, low growing ground cover
- **heuchera** "Beaujolaais" large, vigorous variety, burgundy leaves with a touch of silvering and dark purple veins
- **heuchera** "Blackout" near-jet-black leaves with rounded lobes
- **heuchera** "Caramel" *coral bells*, vigorous selection has large glowing yellow-orange foliage
- **heuchera** "Christa" new leaves are nearly all rose purple with a peach undertone, as leaf matures, peach coloring becomes more prominent
- **heuchera** "Citronelle" robust citron yellow with silver undersides, compact habit
- **heuchera** "Frosted Violet", *coral bells*, deep plum-purple maple shaped leaves with subtle silver markings

- **heuchera** "Marmalade" *coral bells* shiny undulating leaves of umber to deep sienna
- **heuchera** "Midnight Rose" hot-pink splashes on nearly black glossy leaves
- **heuchera** "Miracle" new leaves are chartreuse with a touch of reddish purple in the center, mature leaves are brick red with a gold edge
- **heuchera** "Mocha" the largest dark leaf heuchera around, new leaves are bronze-purple changing to all dark purple-nearly-black
- **heuchera** "Paris" one of the best reblooming heucheras, produces tons of deep rose-pink flowers for several months
- **heuchera** "Peach Flambe" *coral bells*, large peach leaves infused with red, needs shade
- **heuchera** "Pinot Noir", deep purple-black leaves with silver overlay, produces pure white flowers
- **heuchera** "Pistache" a robust grower with large, light, lime-green foliage
- **hibiscus** "Blue River II" *rose mallow*, pure white dinnerplate size flowers, long blooming
- **hibiscus** "Fireball" *rose mallow*, finely cut leaves flushed with purple, giant flaming red flowers 10-12" across
- **hibiscus** "Kopper King" *rose mallow*, coppery purple, maple-like leaves, huge white flowers with red eye
- **hibiscus** "Peppermint Schnapps" 3-4' plant produces 8-10" pink blooms with deep reddish streaks in the petals
- **hibiscus** "Pink Elephant" **BIGGEST BLOOMS IN THE BUSINESS**, 5-6' plant produces 1ft. flowers in mid summer, may rebloom in early fall
- **hibiscus** "Plum Crazy" *rose mallow*, plum-purple maple leaves, with dinnerplate size blooms of lavender purple and darker purple veins ...**wow**

- **hibiscus** "Summer Storm" deep wine-purple foliage, compact habit [3-4'], 8" pink flowers
- **hibiscus** "Sweet Caroline", *rose mallow*, 6-8" wide bright pink flowers atop tall plant from July to frost



- **hibiscus** "Turn of the Century", great late summer color, bicolored blooms appear to swirl open like a 6" pinwheel
- **hypericum** c. "Brigadoon" golden-yellow foliage with reddish edges
- **iris germanica** "Before the Storm" the darkest of the dark, black-purple flowers
- **iris germanica** "Rare Treat" huge white flowers edged with deep blue
- **iris germanica** "Swingtown" bright berry red flowers, prolific bloomer
- **iris v.** "Gerald Darby" multicolored foliage of purple & green, multicolored flowers of purple-blue and yellow-white
- **kalimeris** "Blue Star" everblooming compact plant with pale blue daisy-like flowers over deep green shiny foliage
- **lamium** "Beacon Silver" silvery leaves with green border, lavender-pink flowers
- **lamium** "Cosmopolitan" petite groundcover with small silver leaves and light pink flowers
- **lamium** "Ghost" large selection, tall billowy mass of all-silver leaves topped with eye-catching orchid-purple flowers

- **lamium** "Orchid Frost" silver and green leaves with large orchid colored flowers
- **lamium** "Purple Dragon" silvery foliage, larger spikes of purple snapdragon-like flowers
- **lavandula** "Coconut Ice" *lavender* dense silvery-green upright foliage, 20" when mature, flowers open clear pink then change to white, creating a bi-color effect
- **lavandula** "Grosso" *lavender*, fragrant, plump flower spikes of violet-blue
- **lavandula** "Hidcote" *lavender*, whitish gray leaves and deep violet blue flowers
- **lavandula** "Munstead" *lavender*, rich lavender spikes sweetly perfumed, shorter variety, extra hardy
- **lavandula** "Sawyers" *lavender*, dark blue flowers over dense silver foliage that holds up well, even in cool wet weather
- **lavandula** "Jean Davis" pale pinkish-white fragrant flowers all summer, attractive blue-green foliage
- **leptinella squalida** "Platts Black" low growing plant with feathery bronzy-black foliage
- **leucanthemum** "Aglai" *Shasta daisy* fringed white petals look like shaved coconut, blooms nearly all summer if deadheaded
- **leucanthemum** "Crazy Daisy" *shasta daisy*, frilly double blooms, prolific bloomer 24-28"

- **leucanthemum** "Goldrausch" a large flowered daisy with fringed white outer petals and frilly yellow inner petals, shorter stems do not require staking
- **leucanthemum** "Sunshine" *Shasta daisy*, pale lemon yellow flowers on 36" plant, color is best in afternoon shade, blooms are huge- 3"-5"
- **leucanthemum** "Thomas Killen" *Shasta daisy*, full flowers on thick stems excellent for cutting, 24-30"
- **lewisia c** "Sunset Group" 3-6" plants with clusters of brilliant flowers of pink, salmon, or orange
- **ligularia** "Osirus Fantaisie" elegant, thick, deep green leaves on purple petioles, wavy leaves reveal glossy burgundy undersides, golden yellow daisyish flowers
- **lily asiatic** "Mount Negro" dark mysterious red petals
- **lily Asiatic** "MT Duckling" striking magenta flowers
- **lily Asiatic** "Orange Art" deep orange flowers with burgundy speckles
- **lily formosum** white funnel shaped 6-10" flowers with dark purple stripe down each petal, very fragrant, blooms late summer
- **lily o.** "Conca D'Or" cheery lemon yellow blooms
- **lily o.** "Sorbonne" very fragrant, deep pink blooms
- **lily o.t..** "Albany" white petals with rich red centers
- **lily oriental** "Montezuma" light lavender edges darken to raspberry, 48"
- **lily oriental** "Stargazer" everybody knows this fragrant pink beauty, 42"
- **linum** "Nanum Sapphire" *flax*, lovely blue flowers float above compact fine foliage for 12 weeks in summer
- **lobelia** "Fan Scarlet", *cardinal flower* compact bronze foliage, vivid scarlet flowers prefers moist soil, **hummers love it**
- **lobelia** "Golden Torch" fabulous combination of gold foliage and bright red flowers
- **lobelia** "Monet Moment" extraordinary vigor, masses of huge, **hot-pink flowers**
- **lupinus** "Popsicle Blue" large spikes of solid purple-blue flowers in early summer
- **lupinus** "Popsicle Red" large spikes of solid red flowers in early summer
- **lychnis** "Orange Gnome" *maltese cross*, brilliant orange-scarlet flowers over dark green, flushed with purple leaves, blooms for 8 weeks
- **malva** "Blue Fountain" rich blue flowers on 4' plant are formed all summer
- **malva** "Sweet Sixteen" cotton-candy pink flowers blanket neat upright plant most of the summer
- **monarda** "Grand Parade" lavender-purple blossoms sit atop mid-sized upright plant, excellent mildew resistance
- **monarda** "Pink Lace" light pink flowers top dark stems on mid sized plant
- **monarda** "Raspberry Wine" *bee balm*, buds resemble raspberries that open to wine red flowers, outblooms most varieties, excellent mildew resistance
- **musa basjoo** *hardy banana*, **yes, hardy banana!!!** From Japan, this 6'+ tropical looking plant will survive[-20]f
- **oenothera** "Glowing Magenta" *evening primrose* fuzzy buds open to 4 petaled flowers on spreading dark green foliage
- **orostachys** "Skyrocket Hybrids"
- **oxalis** "Rosea" low mounds of vivid green, clover-like leaves dotted with small pink flowers, blooms all summer, best in moist partial shade to shade
- **papaver** "Little Candyfloss" *dwarf oriental poppy*, soft pink papery flowers with dark purple-black center
- **papaver** "Scarlet O'Hara" *dwarf oriental poppy*, large ruffled red

- **papaver o.** "Central park" *oriental poppy* intense red to deep-purple flowers
 - **papaver o.** "Miss Piggy" *oriental poppy* full double flowers of soft, lavender-pink on stiff stems
 - **papaver o.** "Papillon" *oriental poppy* flowers are hot pink with a hint of lilac
 - **pardancanda** "Sangria" *candy lily*, 3" plum-purple flowers brushed with gold, blue-green sword-like foliage, shiny black seedheads in fall
 - **penstemon** "Blue Buckle" nice compact plant topped with spikes of large blue-purple flowers
 - **penstemon** "Dark Towers" glossy bronze-red foliage is topped with masses of pink flowers, a huge improvement over 'Huskers Red'
 - **penstemon** "Mystica" clumps of lustrous bronze foliage followed by tall stems and cluster of large, light pink flowers
 - **penstemon b.** "Pinacolada" free flowering, heavy bloomers, compact plant, violet-purple flowers
 - **peony** "Duchess de Nemours" fragrant milky white globe shaped blooms are produced in abundance in late spring
 - **peony** "Lady Alexandra Duff" clusters of fragrant double flowers of pale pink, produces many side buds of single flowers
 - **peony** "Nippon Beauty" gorgeous deep red blossoms contrast with thick dark green foliage, blooms prolifically mid summer
 - **peony tenuifolia** *fern leaf peony*, crimson red single flowers, over fine ferny leaves
 - **perovskia** "Little Spire" *Russian sage*, short upright habit, narrow gray-green leaves, lavender blue flowers
 - **phlox** "Junior Dance" compact well branched plants, hot, coral-pink, fragrant flowers all summer, mildew resistant foliage
 - **phlox** "Junior Dream" well branched plants, fragrant bright purple flowers bloom all summer
 - **phlox p.** "Fancy Feelings" *tall phlox* narrow, deep pink petals form perfect stars
 - **phlox p.** "Pixie Twinkle", fragrant baby-pink flowers on more compact plant, good mildew resistance
 - **phlox p.** "Shorty White" clusters of bright white flowers atop sturdy stems
 - **phlox p.** "Orange Perfection" *tall garden phlox* 5"—6" panicles of flaming salmon-orange flowers on strong stems, sweetly scented
 - **phlox s.** "Atropurpurea" *creeping phlox*, wine-red flowers
 - **phlox s.** "Blue Emerald" *creeping phlox* delicate, lavender blue flowers
 - **phlox s.** "Red Wing" *creeping phlox*, pinkish crimson flowers with dark red center
 - **phygelius** "Blaphy" *cape fuschia* purplish-red flowers are carried on burgundy-red stems
 - **phygelius c.** "Coral Princess" pendulous, tubular, coral flowers presented on strong stems
 - **pinellia** tripartite "Dragon Tails" fabulous gold splashed foliage gives rise to fragrant white to green flowers that resemble 'jack in the pulpit', very exciting for woodland garden or containers!
 - **pladycodon** "Fuji Pink" *balloon flower*
 - **pladycodon** "Sentimental Blue" *balloon flower*, dwarf selection
 - **polemonium** "Heaven Scent" robust mound of purple tinged foliage in early spring, fragrant blue flowers appear in late spring
 - **polemonium** "San Juan Skies" a very compact 'Jacob's Ladder', medium blue flowers and silver-green leaves
 - **polemonium** "Touch of Class" low mound of lacy foliage edged in white, pink buds open to pale blue flowers
 - **primula** "Pacific Hybrids" assorted brightly colored, large flowers
 - **primula** "Salvana" deep violet-blue trumpet shaped flowers held in a pincushion-like cluster, stems are powdery silver
 - **pulmonaria** "Majeste" large solid silver leaves, light pink buds open to bluish-pink flower bells
 - **ranunculus** "Brazen Hussy" dark bronze foliage and glossy dark, yellow flowers
 - **rudbeckia** "Goldsturm" *blackeyed susan*, golden yellow daisy-like flowers with brown cone, blooms over long period in late summer
 - **ruellia humilis** *wild petunia* tubular, bell shaped lavender flowers up to 2" across, blooms all summer
 - **sagina s.** "Aurea" *scotch moss* nice, bright gold, low ground cover
 - **salvia** "Marcus" dark violet-purple flowers on dwarf plant, long blooming
 - **salvia** "Pink Friesland" aromatic foliage, rose-pink flower spikes from summer to fall
 - **salvia** "Plumosa" thick plume-like blooms of dusty rose-purple
 - **salvia** "Viola Klose" compact plant, deep violet-purple spikes, deeper and more intense color than other varieties
 - **salvia koyamae** *Japanese yellow sage*, huge creamy yellow flowers appear on tall stems Sept.-Oct. over large heart shaped leaves
 - **sanguisorba obtuse** elegant, oblong leaves and arching stems holding crimson-red, bottlebrush flowers
 - **sarracenia** "Redbug" *pitcher plant* selected for its large number of short upright red pitchers

- **scabiosa** "Vivid Violet" large pincushion flowers of vivid violet are produced from late spring til frost
- **sedum** "Angelina" *stonecrop*, golden yellow evergreen needle-like foliage, in colder months, takes on reddish orange tinge
- **sedum a.** "Coral Carpet" low growing groundcover has tiny bean-like leaves that are bright red during winter and hot dry summer
- **sedum, dwarf assorted**
- **sempervivum** *hens and chicks* (assorted rosettes)
- **sidalcea** "Little Princess" *prarie mallow* bright spiky plant, satiny soft pink flowers on tall spikes
- **silene** "Prairie Fire" brilliant red flowers mid summer on tall plant
- **silene c.** "Bubblemum" native plant blooms multitudes of pink star-like flowers April into May
- **solidago** "Little Lemon" short compact form of *goldenrod*, abundance of lemon-yellow flowers in late summer
- **stachys c.** "Hot Spot Coral" coral-red, tubular flowers on spikes over aromatic grey-green foliage from mid-spring thru early summer
- **stokesia** "Blue Danube" neat mound of foliage, topped with 3-4" lavender-blue flowers
- **stokesia** "Purple Pixie" dwarf stoke's aster, large violet blue flowers on compact plant
- **sysrinchium augustifolium** "Lucerne" *blue eyed grass*, 8" narrow foliage topped by violet-blue flowers in early summer
- **tanacetum** "Robinsons Red" *painted Daisy*, scarlet red daisy-like flowers over ferny green foliage
- **thermopsis** "Sophia" large sunny spikes of yellow pea-like flowers are born on leafy stems
- **tradescantia** "Sweet Kate", *spiderwort*, chartreuse grassy foliage and clear blue flowers thru the summer
- **tricyrtis** "Imperial Banner" upright stems carry glossy green leaves streaked with white, white, orchid-like flowers with purple spots are carried on dark stems
- **tricyrtis f.** "Gates of Heaven" a gorgeous yellow form with glossy foliage, bears spurred flowers heavily spotted with purplish-pink
- **tricyrtis f.** "Golden Leopard" large glossy leaves on arching stems, blooms summer[earlier than other toadlilies] with primrose-yellow flowers
- **tricyrtis h.** "Moonlight" *toadlily* striking chartreuse foliage with orchid-like, purple spotted flowers, blooms in September
- **veronica** "Aztec Gold" *speedwell*, sunproof bright gold leaves form spreading mat, short spikes of sky blue flowers
- **veronica** "Giles van Hees" bright pink flowering spikes, long blooming, easy to grow
- **veronica** "Royal Candles" *speedwell*, masses of violet-blue spikes all summer
- **vinca m.** "Bowlesii" *myrtle* dark green foliage, purple-blue flowers spring and fall
