

WOODIES AT RHODES' 2011

albizia julibrissin "Summer Chocolate" *mimosa*, medium size ornamental tree with short trunk and very broad flattened crown of spreading branches, glorious, black, fern-like leaves and showy clusters of pink flowers produced over most of the summer

buddleia "Bicolor" compact butterfly bush with 10" panicles of lavender and butterscotch flowers
buddleia "Lo and Behold Blue Chip"



new series of miniature butterfly bushes that bloom early and continuously without deadheading


buddleia "Miss Molly"  compact shrub with *shocking* dark sangria-red flowers

buddleia "Miss Ruby"  vivid, rich pink plumes on compact butterfly bush


caryopteris "Lil' Miss Sunshine"





shiny golden foliage on compact plant with abundant blue flowers in late summer

caryopteris "Petit Blue" 

compact plant with shiny dark green foliage and intense floral display of blue flowers in late summer

chaenomeles "Double Take Orange Storm"  flowering quince with bright orange camellia-like blooms in early spring with occasional rebloom

chaenomeles "Double Take Pink Storm"  stunning pink blooms in early spring


clethra "Vanilla Spice"  this standout plant has glossy dark green foliage and extra-large flowers that are pure white and fragrant.


clethra a. "Ruby Spice" a sweetly scented summersweet with bright pink flowers in midsummer

cotinus "Grace" *smokebush*, new leaves emerge wine-red and change to dusky reddish blue, abundant clouds of flowers in early summer, can be trained into a small tree

forsythia "Lynwood Gold" old time favorite with an upright spreading habit and big yellow flowers up the entire length of stem, one of the best and most reliable of forsythias. Flowering stems appear as deep golden wands in April, it is a dense growing plant with an upright habit.

hibiscus s. "Azurri Satin"  a seedless selection with large single blue flowers, strong growing plant with rich color


hibiscus s. "Chiffon White"  *rose of Sharon*, large, pure white

hibiscus s. "Diana" large, single pure-white flowers and waxy dark green foliage


hibiscus s. "Lucy" double red-pink flowers on long flowering shrub

hibiscus s. "Satin Violet"  rich colorful plant with more-than-abundant large single violet-pink flowers from mid-summer to mid fall

hibiscus s. "Sugar Tip"  an eye-catching new rose-of-sharon, brightly variegated creamy-white and blue-green foliage, loads of clear pink double flowers, does not produce seeds

hydrangea a.  "Invincibelle Spirit" reblooming pink "Annabelle", abundant blooms starting midsummer and continuing til frost

hydrangea a. "Incrediball"  new and improved version of "Annabelle" has stronger stems and 4 times as many flowers

hydrangea i. "Blue Bunny"  a drift of blue lacecap flowers from mid summer until fall, blooms on old or new wood, making this a reliable bloomer every year


hydrangea m. "All Summer Beauty" is covered with big, bold blooms of deep blue (in acid soil) or soft pink (in alkaline soil) from midsummer, often until frost. This


shrub reblooms each year because flowers are also produced on new wood.


hydrangea m. "Endless Summer" the original reblooming mophead hydrangea, produces 8" flower heads of pink or blue throughout the summer

hydrangea m. "Twist And Shout" the lacecap version of the popular "Endless Summer" producing lacy pink or periwinkle-blue flowers

hydrangea m. "Let's Dance Moonlight"  strong reblooming mophead flowers of rich blue or pink (depending on soil ph) strong stems and beautiful foliage

hydrangea m. "Let's Dance Starlight"  the first ever new-wood blooming lacecap, hardy colorful and dependable, massive blooms of vivid pink or blue with strong stems


hydrangea p. "Little Lamb"  compact heads of paniculata type flowers on medium-compact plant

hydrangea p. "Little Lime"  dwarf form of the ever-popular "Limelight"

hydrangea p. "Vanilla Strawberry" enormous flower panicles are a blend of vanilla cream and strawberry pink

hydrangea p. tree "Quickfire" tree form that blooms earlier than most other varieties, huge panicles of white that quickly change to rich pink

hydrangea P. "Pinky Winky"  wonderful plant that will bloom regardless of climate or soil, incredible panicles of pink flowers pushing new white blossoms out the tip, blooms mid summer

indigofera amblyantha pink *flowering indigo* rose-purple pea shaped flowers held on upright candelabra-like branches, blooms continuously all summer til frost, can be pruned into a small tree or allowed to be an upright shrub

kerria j. "Superba" an old-time favorite growing well in both sun and part shade, this graceful shrub is probably most loved for its large single yellow flowers resembling small roses.

lespedeza t. "Gibraltar" beautiful weeping shrub becomes a waterfall of pinkish-purple flowers mid-to-late summer


peony s "Hanakisoi" *tree peony*, apricot pink semi-double blossoms

peony s "Shimanishiki" *tree peony*, fully double variety with two-tone flowers striped white and rose-red

peony s. "Kinshi" *tree peony*, golden yellow double blooms on 4-5' shrub

peony s. "Hoki" *tree peony* lipstick red, semi-double blooms

potentilla "Forever Gold"

azalea "Bollywood Star"  **its all about color!** Bright neon, red-pink flowers cover this compact semi-evergreen shrub in spring, glossy,

silver and green foliage supplies color the rest of the season

robinia p. "Purple Robe" A tough tree with billowy foliage and pretty violet-pink late spring flowers, 'Purple Robe' is easy-to-grow. A small to medium-sized deciduous tree, it is a hybrid.

sambucus "Black Lace" 
elderberry dark purple-nearly
black lacy foliage, rivals Japanese
maples for exotic beauty, pink
buds open to lacy white blossoms
May and June


spiraea j. "Double Play - Artist"
 new foliage flushes rich red-
purple in the spring, becoming soft
blue-green, flowers are pure, pure
pink (I find if you sheer these
plants back after flowering, you
will get another flush of blooms)

syringa "Bloomerang Purple" 
lilac, highly fragrant flowers burst
out in spring, and again midsummer
and continue right up until frost, a
compact shrub with mildew
resistant foliage

syringa "Tinkerbelle" tree form of
dwarf lilac, pleasing, spicy
fragrance, wine-red flower buds
that open in late spring

weigela "Ghost"  a cool shrub
with reddish pink flowers in spring,
as summer progresses, the
remarkable foliage turns to a
ghostly iridescent buttercream,
then the shrub reblooms in late
summer.

weigela "My Monet"  a very
colorful variegated dwarf form,
will work well in perennial bed

weigela "Wine And Roses" 
knockyoursocksoff shrub has dark,
burgundy-purple foliage and
intense rosy-red flowers
